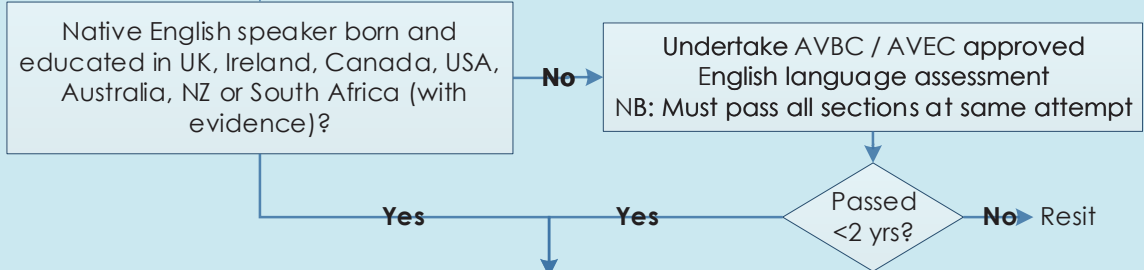


THE AUSTRALASIAN VETERINARY EXAMINATION PROCESS

Step 1: Eligibility Assessment

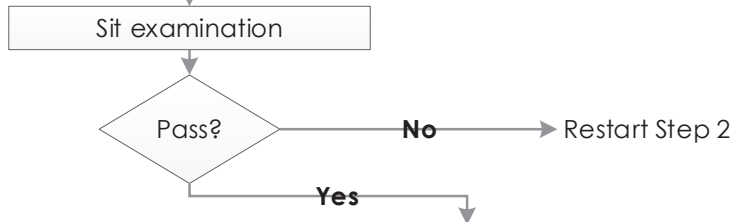
(Note: for each step and each exam in those steps these checkbox criteria must all be met)

- Appropriate veterinary degree/diploma
- Registration, licence or eligibility to work as a veterinarian overseas
- English language assessment



Step 2: Preliminary Examination (MCQ)

- Current English language assessment **No** → See Step 1 (may be waived by AVEC if passed >2 years ago)
- 1st, 2nd or 3rd attempt? **No** → Wait 2 years and seek AVEC counselling



Step 3: Final (Clinical) Examination

- Current English language assessment **No** → See Step 1 (may be waived by AVEC if passed >2 years ago)
- 1st attempt <3 years since passed MCQ **No** → Back to Step 1
- Final attempt <5 years since passed MCQ **No** → Back to Step 1
- 1st or 2nd attempt? **No** → Seek AVEC approval for 3rd attempt
